SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA and AWARD PROCESS

Scholarship is available to an applicant who meets the following criteria.

- Is a full-time college student (undergraduate- 12 credits/semester, graduate - 6 credits/semester), who is currently enrolled in a college or university located in Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, Oklahoma, or South Carolina in a two year, four year or a graduate program (see item 2 above) and demonstrates a keen interest in pursuing a career in hydrographic surveying or related fields.
- High school senior who has applied and been accepted in a full-time U.S. college or university located in Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, Oklahoma, or South Carolina (see item 2 above) with accreditation recognized by the U. S. Department of Education, and who also demonstrates a keen interest in pursuing a career in hydrographic surveying or related fields.

Applicants must be a citizen, permanent resident of the U.S., or hold a student, educational based visa.

If an applicant holds a student visa and is fully funded by GEBCO or NOAA, they cannot apply.

Applicants must be a THSOA member in good standing.

Applications for the current scholarship award will be accepted between April 15 and November 30, 2024 (school year 2024 - 2025).

Applications will be reviewed by the THSOA-Southeast Chapter Education Committee.

Scholarship winners will be announced by January 1, 2025.

For the 2024 - 2025 academic year, awards are expected to be: 6 x \$1000.00 scholarships.

Selection will be based on a combination of academic performance, letters of recommendation, and answers documented in the application process.

Students cannot receive THSOA Southeast Chapter and THSOA National scholarship in the same year.
