#### **SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA**

Scholarships are available to applicants who meet the following criteria:

- Is a full-time college student (Undergraduate 12 credits / semester, Graduate 9 credits / semester), who is currently enrolled in a college or university located in Texas in a two-year, four-year or graduate program and demonstrates a keen interest in pursuing a career in hydrographic surveying or related fields.
- High school senior who has applied and been accepted in a full-time U.S. college or university located in Texas (see item 5 above) with accreditation recognized by the U.S. Department of Education who also demonstrates a keen interest in pursuing a career in hydrographic surveying or related fields.
- 3. Applicants must be a citizen, permanent resident of the U.S., or hold a student / educational based visa. If an applicant holds a student visa and is fully funded by GEBCO or NOAA, they are not eligible to apply.
- 4. Students cannot receive THSOA Houston Chapter and THSOA National scholarships in the same year.
- 5. Applicants must be a THSOA member in good standing student membership or otherwise.
- 6. Applications will be reviewed by the THSOA-Houston Chapter's Education Committee.
- 7. All scholarships must be submitted on or before December 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 8. Scholarship winners will be announced on December 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

## **AWARDS**

Selection will be based on a combination of academic performance, letters of recommendation, and answers documented in the application process. Recipients are expected to participate in the recognition ceremony either:

1. \$1000 in person at the THSOA Sponsored Christmas Event on December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025

Or

- 2. \$750 for students unable to attend *due to academic obligations*, recipients may submit a prerecorded thank-you video (submitted on or before December 8<sup>th</sup>) to include:
  - a. Name
  - b. Education background (university, major, classes of interest)
  - c. What will the scholarship money go toward
  - d. Favorite aspect of hydrography
